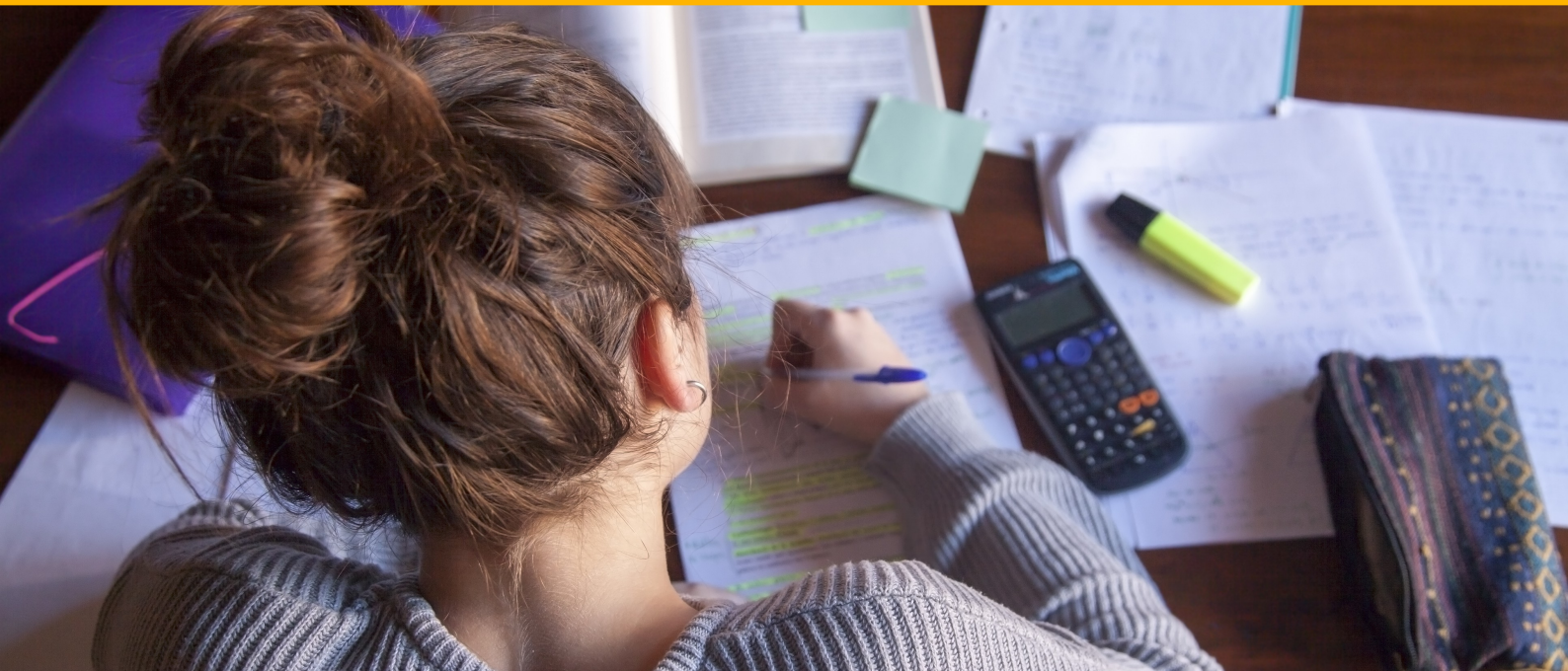

They sit down to study. The phone has other plans.

? What you already see

You've added the laptops, the study-skills units, and the wellbeing check-ins. Most students in Years 10 to 12 still can't hold their attention long enough to do the work in front of them.

The phone is built by some of the smartest people alive to win that fight, and most days it does.

Ask a class how they actually study, and you'll get shrugs, late nights, and panicked cramming the week before.

→ What Brilliant Young Mind does

Brilliant Young Mind is 2 hours that put study back in students' hands. No theory they'll forget by lunch.

Glen names what's actually stealing their focus, then hands them a study system they'll use that night.

Focus is a skill. We give them the words for grit, growth mindset, flow, and mindfulness, and walk them out with a routine they've written down themselves.

What we work through (2 hours)

1 The attention thief

We name what the device is doing to their focus, then take back control of it. Phones away, room quiet enough to think.

2 The study system

Prioritise the load, build a realistic schedule, and set up a desk and a daily routine that beats last-minute cramming.

3 The inner game

Reduce the fear of failure, manage stress, and learn how to trigger flow and a growth mindset when the work gets hard.

4 The goal on the wall

Each student writes a real ATAR or grade goal and the steps to reach it, then puts it somewhere they'll see it every day.

→ Students leave with **an honest read on how they actually study**, a daily routine and a grade goal in their own handwriting, a way to manage the device that's been managing them, and the grit to keep going when it gets hard.

The person on the stage

Glen Gerreyn, founder of The HopeFULL Institute and former Young Australian of the Year (Qld, Community Service). He's spent 25 years building hope into young people, reaching over a million students. 750 schools and counting.

Glen is plain-spoken and direct, and he doesn't swear to win the room. He leads with story, then strategy. Students sit forward. Staff take notes too.

Give Years 10 to 12 two hours that change how they study.

- **Two hours, with breaks.** 2 hours including breaks set by your bell times. Built for Years 10 to 12.
- **In-person only.** On your campus, in your hall. We don't run this online.
- **Room rules that work.** Pen and paper, no phones, quiet enough to think. You provide the hall, AV, and water. We bring the rest.
- **A workbook they take home.** Every student gets the Brilliant Young Mind workbook, so the system they build in the room lands on the desk that night.
- **Book early for choice.** Brilliant Young Mind fills fast before exam blocks and at the start of the year. Get in early for dates that fit your calendar.
